

Free Vaccination Camp Organized at KGP

Kapil Gyanpeeth, as one conscious school, shouldered the National responsibility of getting children vaccinated on January 11, 2022. To ensure immunization and safety of students against COVID-19, the school organized a special vaccination camp to inoculate maximum number of students aged between 15--18 years. Local counselor Mr. Ramavatar Gupta extended his help in organizing this camp.

Students falling in 15 to 18 years of age group of classes IX to XII got vaccinated with the 1st dose of COVAXIN under this drive, which was encouraging.
